Women of the Word: Becoming a Woman Who Pleases God

Description:

Fall Semester class (15 weeks, September through December 2019)

The purpose of this class will be to biblically train younger women how to practically fulfill the commands of God found in Titus 2. For example, we will teach them how to love their husbands: agape love, practical love, sexual love, submissive love. We will teach them how to love their children encompassing various aspects of raising children: training, discipling, disciplining, etc. We will apply this to each aspect of Titus 2:3-5--self-control, purity, workers at home, kindness, and submissiveness to their husbands. We will draw from the Scriptures for the information/instructions regarding these imperatives along with biblical and wise writings of godly men and women who are solid in the Word.

Why You Should Attend:

In Titus 2:3-5 God commands older women to live lives in accordance with sound doctrine, whereby they will be equipped to teach what is good by training younger women to love their husbands, love their children, be sensible, be workers at home, be kind, be subject to their own husband—all with the goal of ensuring that the word of God will not be dishonored. While the class will be focused on the biblical principles which older women are to teach younger women in order that the young women will acknowledge and employ them, we believe every woman who attends (regardless of her age) will be edified, encouraged, and motivated to apply these truths found in Scripture to her own life, and when the time comes, to pass them along to the younger women in the family of God.

Requirements:

You must be a woman. ;) We will ask mothers to use discretion in allowing their younger daughters to join, preferring young ladies to be older teens and above. Mothers of younger daughters will be given advance notice of any classes that may not be age appropriate.
